



Jan de Beer (16e eeuw) Nederland

**Jan de Beer** or **Henneken de Beer** (c. 1475 – 1528), was an Netherlandish painter and draughtsman.

According to the RKD he was the son of the painter Claes de Beer and the father of the glasspainter Arnould de Beer. A student at the Antwerp Guild of St. Luke, he became a master in 1504. In 1515 he became a dean of the Guild. He later took on apprentices, including his son, Aert de Beer.
